

13-14 中英文部課程簡介

辦學宗旨：

本校由慈幼會會士主辦，以會祖聖鮑思高之教育精神及理想，培養學生在德、智、體、群、美各方面均衡的發展。

班級編制：

中文部：初中一至高中三。

英文部：英中一至英中六。

學年編排：

由每年九月至翌年六月為一學年，每一學年分上、下學期，每學期上課二十週。

每學期終結時舉行學期考試，每一學期中段時間則舉行「中期統測」。

(英中六及高中三學生不舉行中期統測，全年考試二次)。

上課時間：

本校為全日制學校，上午上課五節，由八時十五分至中午十二時卅分，其間由十時五分起，小息廿分鐘。

下午上課三節，由二時至四時五分。

課程簡介：

中文部：

由初一至初中三學生須修讀一般性的學科。

初中畢業後，學生可選擇進入文科班或理科班。

高一、二、三年級文組科目：

A. 必修科：修身、中文、英文、數學、電腦、歷史、地理、會計、體育。

B. 高一、高二選修科：音樂、葡文、通識、普通話。

高一、二、三年級理組科目：

理科班之物理、化學及生物取代上述文組之歷史、地理及會計科目。其他之必修科則相同。

英文部：

英文部課程參照英國 IGCSE/GCE/IAL 課程編訂。英文部除中文科及普通話科外均採用英文課本。

由英中一至英中二，學生須修讀一般性之學科。非以中文為母語之學生，如不修讀中文，須選修葡文。

完成中二後，學生可選修中三之商科或理科科目。

英中三至中六之商科及理科科目：

A. 必修科：修身、中文(或葡文)、英文、數學、電腦、體育、美術、音樂。

B. 商科(會計、經濟)或理科(物理、化學)。

C. 選修科：英國文學、生物、地理、葡文。

本校學生報考英國普通教育文憑考試(IGCSE/GCE 'A' LEVEL)概況：

一. 中四學生可報考普通程度 IGCSE 數學、物理、化學或經濟、會計科考試。

二. 中五學生可自選報考普通程度 IGCSE 英文、美術、生物、人體生物、英國文學、地理、資訊科技，高級程度 GCE 'A' Level 中文科，高級補充程度 GCE 'AS' Level 數學、物理、化學或經濟、會計科考試。

三. 中六學生可報考高級程度之數學、物理、化學或經濟、會計，高級補充程度生物、英國文學、地理考試。

四. 中一至中五之學生可依程度報考英國每年舉辦之第一至第五階段英文程度考試(PEARSON TEST OF ENGLISH)。

2013-2014 Brief Introduction of the Curricula of the Chinese and English Sections

Our Mission:

Our school is run by the Salesians of Don Bosco. Our education is based on the Don Bosco's educational methods and ideals providing all round education to the youths.

Class Structure:

Chinese Section: Junior Middle 1 to Senior Middle 3.

English Section: Form 1 to Form 6.

School Year Schedule:

School year starts in September and ends in June. There are two semesters in each school year and 20 weeks of lessons in one semester. In the middle of each semester, there is a mid-term test and at the end of each semester, there is an examination.

(No mid-term tests for students of Form 6 in the English Section and Senior Middle 3 of Chinese Section. They only have to sit for 2 examinations in the whole school year.)

School Hours:

We are a full-day school. Morning classes start at 8:15 a.m. and end at 12:30 p.m. There are 5 periods in the morning and at 10:05 a.m., there is a 20-minutes recess. There are 3 periods in the afternoon from 14:00 p.m. to 16:05 p.m.

Curricula:

Chinese Section:

Students from Junior Middle 1 to Junior Middle 3 have to study all general subjects.

After graduating from Junior Middle 3, they can choose to study in the Arts stream or the Science stream.

For Arts stream Senior students:

A. Compulsory Subjects: Biblical Knowledge, Chinese, English, Mathematics, Computing Studies, History, Geography, Accounting and Physical Education.

B. SM1 and SM2 Elective Subjects: Music, Portuguese, Liberal Studies and Mandarin.

For Science stream Senior students: Instead of History, Geography and Accounting, students of the Science stream have to take Physics, Chemistry and Biology. All other subjects are the same as for Arts students.

English Section:

The English Sections adopted the specifications of Edexcel IGCSE / GCE / IAL Examinations. Except Chinese and Mandarin, all the textbooks are in English.

Students from Form 1 to Form 2 have to study all general subjects. Non-chinese speaking students who do not study Chinese have to take Portuguese instead.

After finishing Form 2, students have to choose Commerce Stream or Science Stream.

For Form 3 to Form 6 Commerce or Science students:

A: Compulsory subjects: Biblical Knowledge, Chinese (or Portuguese), English, Mathematics, Computing Studies, Physical Education, Arts and Music.

B. For Commerce Stream : Accounting and Economics; For Science Stream : Physics and Chemistry.

C. Elective Subjects: English Literature, Biology, Geography and Portuguese.

An overview of Our Students' Participation in the London Examinations:

1. Form 4 students can enter for the IGCSE Mathematics, Physics or Chemistry, Economics or Accounting Examinations.

2. Form 5 students can enter for the IGCSE English, Biology, Human Biology, English Literature, Geography, History or Information Technology examinations, A-Level Chinese and AS-Level Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, Economics and Accounting Examinations. Taking GCE examination is wholly optional.

3. Form 6 students can enter for A-Level Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Economics or Accounting. AS-Level Biology, English Literature or Geography

4. According to their English proficiency levels, students from Form 1 to Form 5 can take the Pearson Test of English Level 1 to Level 5, which are held once a year.
