#### **Using calculators**

For question papers where the use of calculators is allowed, candidates are responsible for making sure that their calculators meet the awarding bodies' regulations.

#### **Calculators must not:**

- a) **be designed or adapted to offer any of these facilities:**
  - language translators;
  - symbolic algebra manipulation;
  - symbolic differentiation or integration;
  - communication with other machines or the internet.
- b) **have retrievable information stored in them - this includes:**
  - data banks;
  - dictionaries;
  - mathematical formulas;
  - text.
  - English dictionaries or translators may not be used.
  - Use of correcting pens, fluid or paper is forbidden
  - Must write in black ink or ball-point pen
